THE MOAH CREEK SOLAR FARM IS ONE OF A PORTFOLIO OF PROJECTS BEING DEVELOPED BY CENTRAL QUEENSLAND POWER (CQP). CQP IS AN AUSTRALIAN DEVELOPER OF RENEWABLE ENERGY PROJECTS THAT WILL CREATE LONG TERM, ENDURING AND RESILIENT ENERGY SOLUTIONS FOR CENTRAL QUEENSLAND.



Construction is expected to start mid 2025 and take approx. 29 months



Up to 150,000 homes powered with clean energy annually



Developable footprint is approximately 950 hectares and has 1 landowner



The project is in the site investigation and preliminary design stage of development.



660,000 solar photovoltaic modules with a generation capacity of 285 MW AC.

The project is located 40 km west of Rockhampton and 30 km north-west of Stanwell, in the Rockhampton Regional Council Local Government Area.
